Teej is a Hindu festival primarily celebrated by women in Nepal and parts of India, especially during the monsoon season (Shrawan). It is a celebration of nature's beauty and the bond between Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati. Women observe the festival by fasting, singing, dancing, and decorating their hands with henna.

On 25th July 2025, Kindergarten students came dressed in traditional attire. A swing activity was set up for students, and they enjoyed swinging on the decorated swings.

Teej activities were organized for students of grades III-IX and XI. Students participated in various activities, including a gemstone accessory competition in the lower grades and a Mehndi competition in grades IX and XI.
