

Earth Day Celebration

Earth Day was celebrated in our school on 22nd April 2026 with great enthusiasm to spread awareness about protecting our environment. The main focus was on keeping our surroundings clean and using the 3Rs – Reduce, Reuse, Recycle. Students of all grades participated in multiple activities that highlighted the value of a clean and green Earth.

The day began with a cleanliness drive at 8:30 AM. Areas covered-School playground, garden, and the nearby community park. Students of Grade III-V, along with teachers, picked up plastic wrappers, dry leaves, and waste paper using gloves and garbage bags. Over 15 bags of litter were collected and segregated into biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste. The park looked fresh and welcoming after the drive.

Students of Grade VI-VIII gathered in Sahibzada Ajit Singh hall for the Earth Day Pledge. The pledge was led by the Head Boy and repeated by all students with their right hand raised. To promote reuse and creativity, a “Best Out of Waste” activity was held for Grades 6-8. They made Pen Stand, Bird Feeder etc. Judging Criteria was creativity, usefulness, and neatness.

Students of Grade- Nursery-UKG presented a role play based on Earth day as Mother Earth felt sick due to pollution and deforestation. The ‘Students’ group promised to plant trees, save water, and say no to plastic. Students of Grade-I & II did plant sampling in the school ground area.

The Earth Day celebration was a great success. Through the cleanliness drive, pledge, role play, and best out of waste activity and plant sapling, students understood their responsibility towards Earth.

The day ended with the message: **“Clean Earth, Green Earth – Our Dream Earth.”**
